Guidelines, Evaluation & Submission details

This competition aims at enhancing youth participation in the lens of global agenda to creatively pen down their thoughts, story, imagination, vision related to any of the following- (choose a topic which is related to any of the following themes)

- No Hunger
- Reduced Inequalities
- Responsible Consumption
- Gender Equality
- Environment & Climate

Rules and guidelines: -

- Entries must be relevant and in the spirit of the competition.
- Excerpts may range from 600-800 words in length.
- Entries must be in English or Hindi
- It is entirely based on individual participation; no groups.
- All entries must be word processes and adequately spaced.
- Entries must be entirely the work of the entrant and not published previously; it will be checked for plagiarism.
- The judge's decision will be final and no individual correspondence will be entered into.
- Pieces may be written in the form of essays, speeches, article or poems.
- Each entry should be assigned an appropriate title
- Failure to comply with the above rules will result I disqualification from the competition.

Submission Details: -

- Cover page must include-
 - 1. Title of the writing
 - 2. Full name of the participant
 - 3. Age
 - 4. Contact details (email, mobile no.)
- Submissions must be in the form a .doc, .docx or .pdf.

Evaluation Criteria:-

The entries will be judged on the following parameters-

- Clarity and originality of expression
- Thought process (creative/inspiring/ reality)
- Passion for concern/Empathy
- Use of language (effective not necessary muscular vocabulary)
- Use of Imagination / Rhetoric
- Ideas /Solutions/ Insights
- Creativity/Innovative thinking
